# Origin

**C. Jon Wineland** represented CWA members of the NJ Judiciary for over 20 years. Jon was known for his fiery defense of members' rights, his tireless organizing, and his commitment to social justice. He was an important leader in the original Judiciary organizing campaign, bringing union rights to thousands of unrepresented public employees. Jon passed away in 2001.

**Virginia Wolf** represented State Worker and local government members for over 30 years, serving NJ Department of Labor, Motor Vehicles, Treasury, Burlington County, and municipal groups. Virginia was "old school," strongly advocating through thousands of grievances, disciplines, and workplace issues. Everyone who came in contact with Virginia knew her favorite thing was to confront management on behalf of our members. Virginia passed away in 2011.

Jon and Virginia worked tirelessly protecting workers' rights and building union strength their entire adult lives. Both were comrades, friends and staunch advocates for ALL working people. It is the desire of Local 1036 to keep both Jon and Virginia's memories alive by annually honoring others who also exhibit these qualities.

# Nominee Eligibility

The award nominee will be an individual who is a **member in good standing** of CWA Local 1036 for **at least one year**.

### **Nomination Criteria**

This award will be presented to a member who has been nominated by a union sibling, staff representative or Education Committee member for demonstrating a selflessness, commitment, political involvement and dedication to building the strength, ideals and principles of the Union in their worksites or in their community.

### **Award**

Two \$500.00 scholarships for attending a union-related training, conference, or continued education of the recipients' choice.

# **Manner of Selection**

The Local 1036 Education Committee will collect and forward recommendations to the Executive Board for final determinations.
