REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a student enrolled in the 2026 academic year who is a child of a member in good standing of CWA 1036
2. Applicant must have a grade point average of “C” or better and be attending a college or university, apprenticeship or trade school program of study in the Fall of 2026.
3. Applicant is personally responsible for securing proof of eligibility for the scholarship, as specified under verification of union membership and academic verification.
4. Applicant must prepare an essay, not to exceed 500 words, in response to the question on the following page.
5. Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from a professor, course instructor or advisor.
6. Two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$2,000.00 each shall be submitted to the registrar of the school the scholarship recipients are attending for the Fall 2026 semester.
